General Election Rules

- i. Any member wishing to run for an officer position must fill out and sign the appropriate self-nomination form. Completed forms must be submitted no less than 30 minutes before election.
- ii. Members may run for more than one position, **but may only accept one position** if he/she wins more than one position. In this case, he/she **must accept the highest-ranking position won.** (with the exception to rule number 3 below)
- iii. Any sole member on the ballot for a position must still be elected by the general membership. If the sole member wins this position in the case described, while also winning another position, the member may choose to accept both positions.
- iv. Members must have a **minimum of 1 year until graduation** in order to be eligible to run for the following positions: President and Executive VP.
- v. **Official election are held on April 7th in BSN 1201** of the Tampa Campus Business Building during the regularly scheduled AMS Meeting.
- vi. **Members must be present to vote** and each member will have one vote per position.
- vii. All election ballots will be counted and audited on April 7th **by the current President and Faculty Advisor.** Results will be announced after all ballots have been counted, audited and released by the Faculty Advisor.
- viii. The above rules may be amended with sufficient notice to all members.
